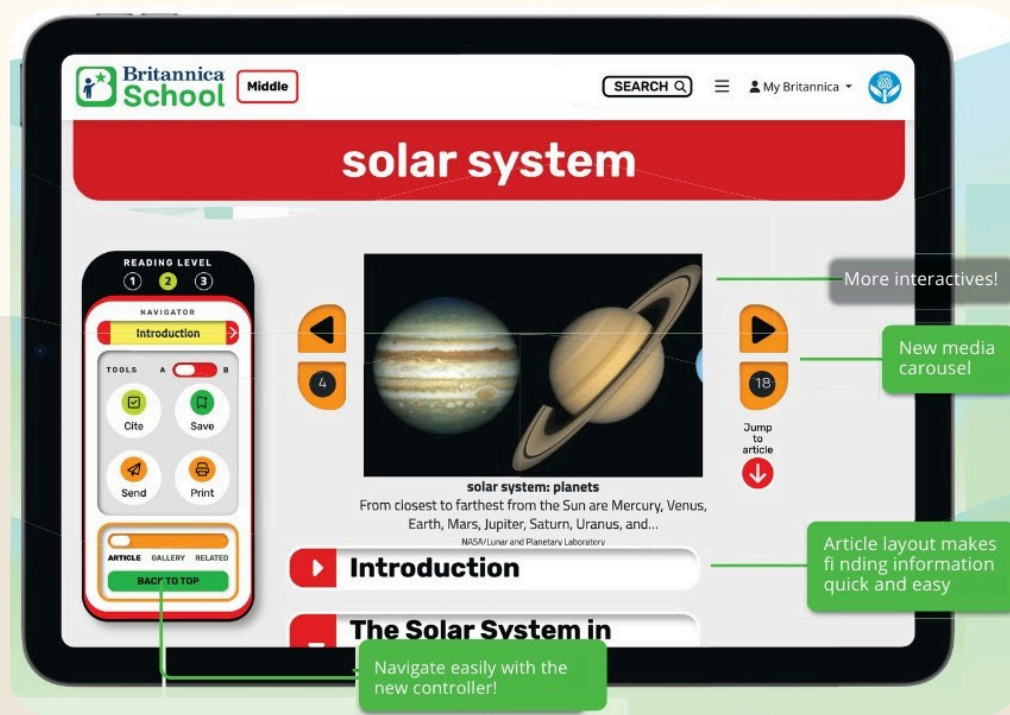

SIGN UP FOR FREE CEU CLASSES



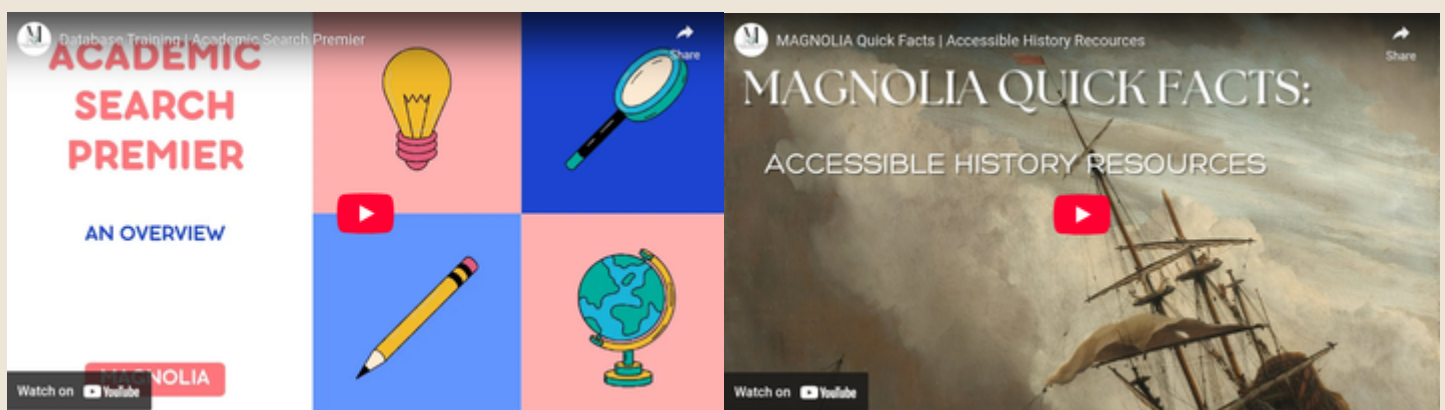
