This October, we invite you to join us for one of the most exciting and patriotic State Fairs Mississippi has ever hosted. From October 2 to 13, the Mississippi State Fairgrounds in Jackson will be alive with the sights, sounds and flavors of a tradition that spans generations — now made even more special as we kick off the national celebration of America250, the 250th anniversary of our nation's founding.

This year's State Fair will be wrapped in red, white and blue, honoring our country's rich heritage and the farmers, families and communities who represent the backbone of Mississippi and America. You'll feel the spirit of freedom and pride from the moment you walk through the gates. Whether you're coming for the thrills, the tastes, the music or the memories, there's something for everyone at the America250 Fair!

Visitors can expect all their favorite fair attractions, including over 60 exhilarating carnival rides provided by North American Midway Entertainment and more than 100 food vendors, featuring everything from classic fair foods to the beloved Biscuit Booth, hosted by your Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce.

We're proud to continue celebrating our agricultural roots through a full lineup of agricultural events: from daily 4-H and FFA livestock shows, the crowd-favorite Pretty Cow Contest (October 10), the Tri-State Rodeo (October 4-5), and the Horse, Mule and Pony Pulls (October 10-11), to the ever-engaging FARMtastic Exhibition, with live chick hatching, beehives, antique tractors and hands-on ag education. On October 11, we'll host 4-H Day, a salute to the young people shaping the future of agriculture in Mississippi. In Patriot Village, you can experience the Taste of the Dixie National Rodeo, offering a sampling of rodeo flair with weekday shows at 7pm and weekend shows at 2pm and 7pm.

The 2025 Mississippi State Fair is more than just fun — it's a celebration of the American spirit. This year, we're proud to introduce Military Mondays and First Responder Fridays, where veterans, active-duty military members and first responders will receive free admission on their corresponding days, with proof of ID. Senior American Day, where we celebrate and accommodate our treasured senior citizens on Wednesday,

October 8, will include a performance by music artist Ronnie McDowell, as well as two all-new patriotic shows. You won't want to miss these incredible shows featuring a historical theatrical presentation, "For God and Country," by Pine Grove Church of Walnut Grove and a musical celebration of our American Freedom, "Let Freedom Ring!" by the First Baptist Jackson Choir and Orchestra. Senior American Day is open to groups and organizations of all ages as we pack out the Mississippi Coliseum for a full day of patriotic festivities.

The fun continues across the grounds with family-friendly attractions like the Zerbini Family Circus, the Farm Bureau Petting Zoo, pig races, and the all-new Paul Bunyan Lumberjack Show, thrilling audiences daily with high-flying feats and timber sports. Fairgoers will also experience performances by Mississippi school bands and other groups throughout the duration of the fair at our designated 'Liberty Landing.' And don't forget the Kid Zone, filled with kiddy rides and fun for the youngest fairgoers.

The entertainment lineup at this year's fair is sure to impress. Inside the Mississippi Coliseum, enjoy performances from musical artists All 4 One and Montell Jordan; Corey Asbury; and Maddie & Tae and Tayler Holder. Tickets purchased for these concerts also include general admission to the State Fair.

And on our final day of the Mississippi Great American State Fair, don't miss the Grand Finale of our all-American festivities. The day kicks off at 9:30am with the first-ever Great American Parade, featuring military groups, wagon trains, marching bands, patriotic floats and more. That evening, award-winning Lee Greenwood will perform his iconic "God Bless the USA" and other classics, followed by a spectacular fireworks display — all included with regular fair admission!

We can't wait to welcome you to the 2025 Mississippi Great American State Fair as we come together to celebrate 250 years of freedom, heritage and heart. It's a time to honor our past, embrace our present and look boldly to the future. Don't forget to wear red, white and blue! See you at the Fair!



SECURITY POLICY

Sunday through Thursday from 6pm until close and all day Friday and Saturday, any guest under the age of 18 seeking admission to the fairgrounds must be accompanied by an adult 21 or older.




